Organizatia politica independenta a refugiatilor din Romania pe teritoriul maghiar, Romania Libera, se alatura chemarii lansate de Grupul din Berlinul de Vest la " Ziua de Actiune: Romania ".

Pe data de 15 noiembrie 1988, cind se implineste un an de la manifestatia muncitorilor din Brasov, se va organiza la Budapesta, o manifestatie de protest, impotriva regimului de dictatura de la Bucuresti si pentru respectarea Drepturilor Omului in Romania. Aceasta va avea loc linga Ambasada Romaniei din Budapesta, in Parcul Solidaritatii Maghiaro-Romane si va incepe la ora 16,30. Mentionam ca din cele 30 de articole din Declaratia Universala a Drepturilor Omului, semnata si de Romania, numai 2 sint respectate de guvernul de la Bucuresti.

APPEAL

The independent political organization of the Romanian Refugees on the territory of Hungary, entitled Free Romania, joins the appeal launched by the Group from West Berlin at “Action Day: Romania.”

On 15 November 1988, when we commemorate one year since the workers’ rally in Braşov, it is to be organized in Budapest a protest campaign against the dictatorship from Bucharest and for the observance of Human Rights in Romania. This is to take place next to the Romanian Embassy in Budapest, in the Hungarian-Romanian Solidarity Park and is to start at 16:30. We specify that out of the 30 articles of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, signed also by Romania, only 2 are observed by the government in Bucharest.

In our turn, we call on to everybody, in the whole world, for similar protesting actions from those who are not indifferent to the tragic situation in Romania, to display their opposition to the antihuman politics of Ceauşescu’s regime.

We appeal to all the Romanians within the country and abroad, to stop from their daily activities on 15 November 1988 at 10 o’clock, the moment when the workers in Braşov came out in the streets, to keep a moment of silence in remembrance of those who sacrificed themselves asking for their rights, and that each and everyone should think of a free Romania.

May the power of our common thought give us strength and courage in our peaceful fight for liberty and democracy in Romania!
